Another great adventure with some Chapter Friends brought me this memory. Can you see Lori? She is the tall one in the middle of the pool.



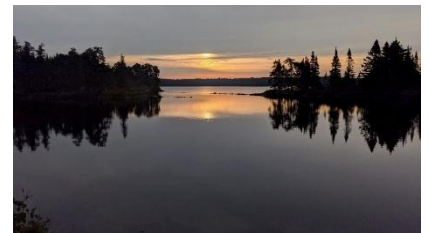
Is this or the motor cycle picture taken later in the day?

ABATE NEWS

Greetings R.R Family. Well, the Groundhog has made his predictions and if you put your faith into it, 6 weeks from now it will be the end of March.

That's the only prediction that's for sure.

Tuesday the 17th of this month is a very important day for us motorcyclists. It's Lobby Day in Madison when ABATE and anyone who rides has an opportunity to talk to our lawyer about preserving our rights to ride. This year there are some very important issues that if we don't fight for and win, will start the beginning of the end of fuel for our motorcycles along with our right to repair them.

Here is an example of our E10 or less fuel going away. Everyone knows to move a mountain you start by moving one stone at a time. To lose E10 or less you start with changing one pump at a time. About a week ago I stopped at a gas station to fill up. I was shocked to see that there was a new hose with a new sticker saying 51% - 83% ETHANOL. For Flex Fuel Vehicles. May Harm Other Engines. How long before E10 hoses are eliminated? It's not hard to see the handwriting on the wall when there are radio commercials saying E15 is the best thing ever.

One thing they don't say is if you ride a motorcycle, ATV's or any other recreational vehicle you can't use it to fuel their engines. This is one of 3 issues that we need to address with our lawmakers! I'm asking for you to help us by getting on the bus and showing up in Madison Tuesday the 17th. United we stand, divided we fall. We have a bus that will arrive at the Park and Ride on the corner of Meadowbrook and Golf road at 9:45am. It leaves at 10:00am for Madison. It will drop you off back at the Park and Ride around 5:00pm. Plenty of time to get to the R.R. chapter meeting that night. Hope to see you there!

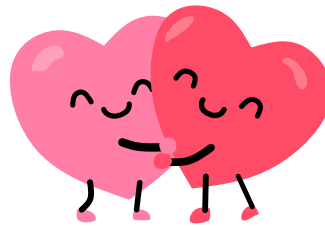
