The Ride 365 program runs January 1 to December 31 and as of the November Chapter meeting, we have 15 members who have ridden more than 10,000 miles in 2023!

Our Chapter as a whole has accumulated almost 427,000 miles. This total ranks us 37th nationwide and first in the State of Wisconsin! Participation includes 85 members, which gives an average 5,020 miles/participating member.

If you have a passenger, they count also. Remember to have their HOG number when your mileage is recorded.

When you get your bike out in the spring, have the mileage recorded. The ending mileage does not carry forward for the annual mileage.
